Facilities include an indoor pool built in the old pineapple house, a spa and sauna, plush gardens and bedrooms decorated with modern, traditional furniture and decor. 12th - 19th May



21st - 29th May 2026

You will find Estonia at the far easterly end of the Baltic Sea, to the north, Finland, and to the south, the remaining Baltic countries of Latvia and Lithuania. 


We cannot wait to welcome you on this cultural journey and we're sure the places explored will remain with you for a long time to come!



13th - 20th October



Some say that the displays are of dragons fighting in the sky, other say that if you give birth under the beautiful night displays then the birth experience will be pain free and, in Greenland, the mystics believed that the mysterious green lights were a ball game between people using a walrus skull as a ball. The Northern Lights can inspire us in so many ways and we invite you to form your own interpretation by joining us in Tromsø, Norway. We will be staying in a cosy, seven bedroom house, just south of Tromsø on a fjord known as Ramfjord. Just thirty minutes from the island of Tromsø, nestled on the shores, we can enjoy the island known as the 'Capital of the Northern lights'. By day, it is a refuge of tranquillity packed with wildlife where we'll be looking out for white-tailed eagle, porpoise, orcas and sea otter. But of course, it's the evening where true wonder occurs and from our house we will have the perfect vantage point to watch the skies for those magical lights. Our itinerary will include a visit to The Sami people, where we will learn about their culture, help to feed their flocks of reindeer and sit alongside them in their huts whilst eating a Sami traditional lunch around a cosy fire. We will also be taking a trip from Tromso on a small boat, down the fjord with our friends at Polar Adventures, a five-hour trip to enjoy, not least because it includes lunch with fresh fish caught by us! Our friend Daniel, from Flexitours, will give us a guided tour of Kvaløya, (which means Whale Island), including stunning deserted sandy beaches. We will take the time to stroll around the cosy town of Tromsø, visiting its cafes, shops and churches, all of which are surrounded by snow-covered Norwegian mountains. Why not come and join us on a trip that will stay with you for an eternity!

Offsetting our Carbon Footprint

Go Beyond Holidays has been taking action to tackle the carbon footprint that we are responsible for each year. In early 2024., we met up with Lea Jacquot-Benson from Positively Touristing, who helps organisations within the tourist industry to calculate and offset their carbon emissions. We have been working with Lea who has set down some guidelines for us to follow. Lea's plan has enabled us to calculate our carbon footprint for 2025 and also to plan how much money we need to raise to donate to projects that are involved with Carbon Offsetting.



Local Fruit Tree Project

As recommended by Positively Touristing, we have chosen a local partner, close to where Go Beyond directors, Anna and lan live, in France. We will be working with the Parc Natural Régional du Verdon who have an existing project in place which preserves old varieties of fruits typical of the Verdon region (apples, pears, plums and figs), that make up an important part of the local heritage and biodiversity. The money donated by Go Beyond will help the park to propagate and distribute these traditional varieties by offering trees to local residents of the Verdon region who can plant them in their gardens and help to preserve them This way, we will be able to visit and see for ourselves the progress that is made and, eventually, we hope to become involved with helping to plant fruit trees.



How will we raise the funds?

The money you pay for your holiday will include a small amount that we will donate to the Parc Natural Régional de Verdon. Go Beyond will also contribute 50% towards monies raised by funds generated from guests. The money collected in 2026 from the holidays you book, will be used to plant trees in the spring of 2027.

I hope you agree with us, that this is a small price to pay for our carbon emissions that are harmful to the environment that act as an accelerator to climate change. Together we can do our part.
